94. HIGH STREET - TRAFFIC CALMING

The Council considered the Public Consultation letter and agreed Saturday 9th December would be the date of the for the Public Meeting in the Community Library. It will be held between the hours of 9am to 7pm and Councillors will provide cover in the Library on a rota basis.

It was also agreed that the consultation letter and maps will be collected from the Community Library on Saturday 25th November at 10am and distributed by Councillors as soon as possible after this date to all residents in Bagillt.

Councillor K. Rush how the voting process will work on the day. It was suggested that residents who attend the Public Meeting will be issued with a ballot paper and marked off the Electoral Register. One vote per resident.

Councillor M. A. Reece reported that Holywell Town Councillors have offered to count the votes.

RESOLVED: The Clerk will obtain copies of the Electoral Register to assist with voting process and will provide ballot papers for the residents to vote at the Public Meeting.

95. PLANNING – LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Councillors considered the Flintshire Local Development Plan 2015 – 2030 Preferred Strategy. The Preferred Strategy document outlined the Plans vision, issues and objectives, preferred level of growth and preferred spatial strategy. It identifies two Strategic Sites and Strategic Policies.

The Clerk advised that copies of the Pre-Deposit Proposals documents were now available for public inspection until Thursday 21 December 2017. Any comments on the Pre-Deposit Proposals documents, the Candidate Sites Assessment and other

supporting information, as well as the submission of alternative sites must be made in writing and received by the Council by 5pm on Thursday 21 December 2017.

The Chairman said Councillors could take the Comments form away to allow more time to study the Preferred Strategy and make comments if they wish.

RESOLVED: That the Flintshire Local Development Plan 2015 – 2030 Preferred Strategy was considered and noted.

96. BAGILLT VILLAGE ROAD SIGNS

The Chairman informed the Council that a revised quote and design had been received by Flintshire County Council for the Welcome Sign. Copies were circulated at the meeting.

Councillor B. T. Doleman suggested relating to ‘Twinned with Laxey’, the sign should include I.O.M. Laxey to ensure people are aware Laxey is in Isle of Man. Councillors agreed.

RESOLVED: That the matter be placed on the January agenda pending the amended design and quote being received from Flintshire County Council.

97. MEMBERS ITEMS

Councillor M. A. Reece informed the Council that the Bowling Club were holding a meeting on Friday 17th November to confirm if the club was to close due to lack of interest and support. Councillor Mrs. J. Nicholas suggested the club should display posters in the village to ask for help and support.

Councillor K. Rush updated the Council regarding the Childcare Offer at Ysgol Merllyn. The Headmaster and Andrew Redfern, Family Information Service Officer set up a steering group and completed an application form which will be submitted to the Child Care Offer for Wales Corporate Funding. If the grant is successful, disabled facilities will be installed and the school will then be able to offer the child care scheme.
